Divisions will be determined with the fastest run setting the 1D time.

Example: If the fastest run is 7.0, then all runs that are 7.1 or slower are in the 1D. The 2D runs are then determined by the run that is 1 second off the 1D time. So the run that is 8.0 or slower will be at the top of the second division and so on.

The 4D format (with a 1 second split between divisions) will be used to determine average winners.

Must compete in both rounds. Times will not be rolled from the 1st round to the 2nd round.
Short round~~ Depending on the number of contestants, X number from each D will compete in a short round for average prizes.

2 go rounds plus a short go
1 second split between divisions
High School rules apply
