TY TUFF CHALLENGE EVENTS

Health & Safety Guidelines

CONTESTANTS

1. If contestant is experiencing flu-like and COVID-type symptoms, please do not participate and leave the rodeo grounds to protect the health of all PRCA members.

Flu symptoms: fever, cough, sore throat, runny/stuffy nose, muscle/body aches, headaches, and fatigue.

COVID-19 symptoms: fever, tiredness, dry cough. Some people may experience aches/pains, nasal congestion, runny nose, sore throat, and diarrhea.

2. It is important to maintain social distancing and follow health requirements for the protection of contestants, stock contractors, contract personnel, rodeo committee personnel, volunteers, and fans.
 - Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue, then throw tissue in the trash.
 - Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. If soap and water are not available, use hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
 - Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
3. Individuals should not congregate in groups larger than 10 individuals at any given time.
4. Contestants should practice Safe distancing and be at least six feet apart whether on horse or on foot.
5. Contestants should not congregate near entry and exit gates.
6. Contestants shall exit arena at end of run and asked to follow social distancing guidelines.
7. Rodeo Committees and contract personnel will minimize and limit the exchange of items between contestants.
8. Mask and gloves are optional but should be considered if you have underlying health conditions.
9. Frequently visited areas the Ty Tuff Contestants may use will be sanitized frequently throughout the event.

RODEO OFFICE/ PERSONEL

1. Entries should be done online at www.rodeoticket.com or mailed in prior to the event.
2. Six feet is required while standing in line at rodeo office.
3. If questions or concern can be answered through a phone call or text please use that option; Phone numbers will be posted on the outside of the office.
4. Only one person at a time at the secretary table; when person leaves area will be sanitized.
5. All draws will be posted outside the office on designated places that will be listed at the office and facebook.
6. Rodeo personnel will follow social guidelines and wash hands frequently.
10. Event Producers will provide sanitizing wipes and/or sanitize entry and exit points of rodeo office regularly.
11. Masks and gloves will be available for personnel and will be worn if needed.
12. Judges and stock contractors will have sanitizing spray to use when needed.
